<b>General pre service Training</b>	<b>08 hrs</b> 2 sessions of 4 hrs each or 1 session of 8 hours	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ General overview -Attachment and Loss, fostering self esteem, different roles of care givers, Brain Development- developmental stages, SIDS, Shaken Baby syndrome, age appropriate activities for children etc.</li> <li>○ Abuse neglect and exploitation of children and reporting</li> <li>○ Emergency Procedures and disaster policy: reporting serious incidents</li> <li>○ Preventing the spread of communicable diseases</li> <li>○ Agape Discipline policy and Behavior Modification program.</li> <li>○ Documentation</li> <li>○ DFPS Minimum standards, Contract and Youth for Tomorrow standards.</li> <li>○ Children’s Rights</li> <li>○ Confidentiality</li> <li>○ Cultural Diversity</li> <li>○ Agency Drug Testing Policy and Procedures</li> </ul>
<b>Non emergency Behavior Intervention</b>	<b>08 hrs</b> 2 sessions of 4 hrs each or 1 session of 8 hours. May attend 8 hours of behavior management training such as conflict resolution, defiant children,etc offered by other agencies	Discipline and Behavior intervention module of PRIDE- 6A and 6B) Early signs, De-escalation, conflict resolution, behavior contract etc.
<b>Emergency Behavior Intervention(SAMA, CPI or PAPH)</b>	<b>08 hrs</b> One session of 8 hours	early identification of potential problem behaviors and strategies and techniques of less restrictive interventions Different roles and responsibilities of caregivers, Escape and evasion techniques, Safe implementation of the restraint techniques, The physiological and psychological impact of emergency behavior intervention etc
<b>Medication Training</b>	<b>03 hrs</b>	Psychotropic medication, psycho pharmacology , side effects, adverse reactions, documentation etc.

<b>CPR ( Infant and Adult) and First aid</b>	<b>04 hrs</b>	Infant , child and Adult CPR First Aid.
